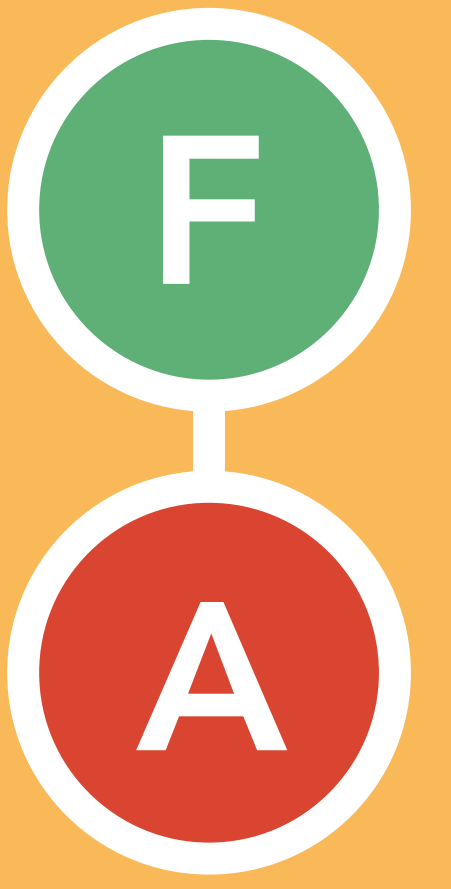

So far, **4,595 students**, accompanied by **497 teachers**, have been trained in Peace Education. The project's efforts proved that quiet diplomacy, persistence and **knocking on the doors of people who are not already on your side** helps to create shared spaces.

PEACE EDUCATION IN A DIVIDED COUNTRY

Cyprus remains divided to this day as a result of **intercommunal violence and foreign interventions**. 'Imagine' aims to **increase contact, communication and collaboration** between the two communities and promotes peace, understanding and anti-racism, together with a holistic understanding of a Culture of Peace and Non-Violence.

PREPARING AND PAIRING STUDENTS

Trainers visit schools to facilitate **discussions on stereotypes, discrimination and racism**. This prepares students for the next step where **they are paired with a group from the other community** to participate in Peace Education activities. As a third step, sustainability actions and teacher trainings are implemented.
